


## Consultations in Interreg NEXT –

## <u>Introduction</u>

The majority of the ENI CBC programmes have already launched the programming phase to define the future Interreg NEXT programmes. The programming exercise, as stressed by the European Commission in several instances, shall rely on the appropriate involvement of relevant partners, as it increases ownership, transparency and legitimacy. This involvement in programming also lays the foundations for a solid programme implementation.

## But...how to move from the principle to the operational tools?

In order to make the partnership principle a methodological approach in the definition of the future programme strategies, TESIM organises a webinar targeting the staff of the Managing Authorities and Joint Technical Secretariats.

Using as a reference the Guidance and Toolkit issued by TESIM and shared with programmes on 2 April, the aim of the webinar is two-fold:

- To provide the managing bodies with the key insights and methodological guiding principles on how to carry out the actions required for such kind of consultation under the new regulatory framework;
- To introduce hands-on tools and methodologies for effective consultations (TESIM Toolkit)

As anticipated, the package has been drafted prior to the COVID-outbreak, and the proposed approach builds mostly on the organisation of presential and interactive consultations. A partial adaptation of the toolkit to a more balanced combination of presential and online consultations, with a view to mitigating the effects of a potential prolonged lockdown, has been undertaken and will be available after the webinar.
