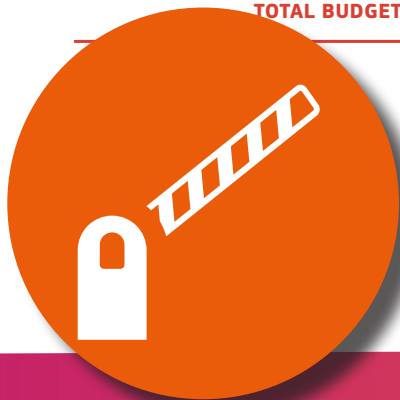

The main objective of the project is to foster cycling and develop cycling routes between Russia and Finland. To do so, the project partners are creating a new cycle path in the City of Svetogorsk (RU) and improving the border checking point at the Russian-Finnish border with new cycling infrastructures. As a result, the new cycle path will form the basis for a cycling route network in the area. The project organizes seminars on cycling safety and a bike ride from St.Petersburg/Svetogorsk (RU) to the city of Imatra (FI). The final goal is to improve the mobility, safety, sustainability and social development of both residents and tourists on both sides of the border.
