The Foreigners' Registration Centre (FRC) operating in Pabrade is the only centre in Lithuania for accommodation of foreigners detained for illegal entry or stay and asylum-seekers for the period of examination of their applications. The FRC operated from the degraded, overcrowded military barracks with poor accommodation and working conditions. The project has helped to reconstruct the old premises and create new facilities for staff and foreigners accommodated at the FRC. The relocation of the FRD Pabrade Team and Vilnius CPHQ Pabrade Police Station to the Center has improved public safety and security at the site and its surroundings. The project as well fosters cooperation between the Lithuanian and Belarusian partners to find an uniform approach to migration-related international instruments in the two countries.
