The BCPmonitoring project partners aim at creating a modern and effective system of information exchange between the border agencies of Ukraine and Poland. This is done through the equipment of the Ukrainian border guard units with unmanned aerial vehicles with digital video and thermovision cameras. The Polish side benefits from a new surveillance system, consisting of thermal and day light imaging cameras, a perimeter protection system and data transmission equipment. The use of unmanned aerial vehicles and joint patrolling enables equally efficient operations between border service of both countries, creating strong partnership and exchange of experiences.
