Religious artefacts belonging to Saint Hierarch Gavriil Bănulescu–Bodoni were discovered in 2016, during archaeological researches carried out at Căpriana Monastery, in the Republic of Moldova. The overall objective of the project is to preserve and promote this common heritage, a unique ecclesiastical patrimony with historical value for both Romania and Moldova. The project is going to create the first religious museum at Capriana Monastery where the artefacts will become part of the permanent exhibition; and a digital exhibition at the “Moldova” National Museum Complex of Iasi Romania about the same relics, to stimulate interest and promote religious tourism. An international symposium, a training programme in the field of heritage conservation and two events addressing travel agencies representatives are also being organised.
