The aim of the project is to develop the socio-economic potential of women, overcoming local challenges in demography and labour market. The project is going to create a network of equipped resource centres for women in the programme regions of Latvia and Russia. It will involve professional coaches to deliver pilot trainings for economically active women, as well as for local mentors, which will continue working in the research centres after the project lifetime. Local small and medium enterprises will be involved in the research centres’ activities both as potential employers and business experts. It is expected that the network of research centres will set up long-term cooperation to exchange knowledge and develop international economic relations. It will help women adapt to labour markets and contribute to increase of self-employment and the number of new small and medium enterprises.
