

WHAT'S NEW FOR INTERREG NEXT?

<u>Background</u>

The event is the third stage in a series of events focussed on the novelties of the legal framework for 2021-2027:

- 14 of April for all Interreg programmes
- 20 of April for all external cooperation programmes in Interreg
- 27 April for Interreg NEXT programmes

The first two events, organised by Interact, will consist in a read-through of the novelties in the Regulation and questions and answers sessions with EC officers. Considering that the implications of the new regulation are different for Interreg NEXT than for internal Interreg and IPA CBC, TESIM organises a **practical workshop on 27 April**, which will be devoted to an open discussion on the specificities for neighbourhood cross-border cooperation programmes.

During the event, a short introduction on the novelties having a special relevance to Interreg NEXT will be provided. Programmes will then be split in two breakout rooms: one for the programmes with Russia and another for the rest. The breakout rooms will allow for an open discussion on the practical implications for the programmes and they will be followed by a short wrap-up session.

When registering, participants are invited to indicate which are the most relevant topics where they may have doubts on interpretation, or where decisions need to be taken during the programming phase.
