TOTAL BUDGET

The boundaries between Russia, Finland and Norway are crossed daily by hundreds of travelers. Bus trips are not always easy: poor connection to domestic bus routes, no joint information platform with destinations and timetables, limited possibilities for buying tickets online challenge travelling across borders. The "Barents on Time" project provides cross-border travelers with up-to-date tools and services: a dedicated website with timetable and information screens on bus stops. The project helps to prioritize public transport at cross-border checkpoints. It also develops an efficient timetable connecting local and cross-border transport, and it has generated an emergency plan to increase safety of cross-border public transport.
