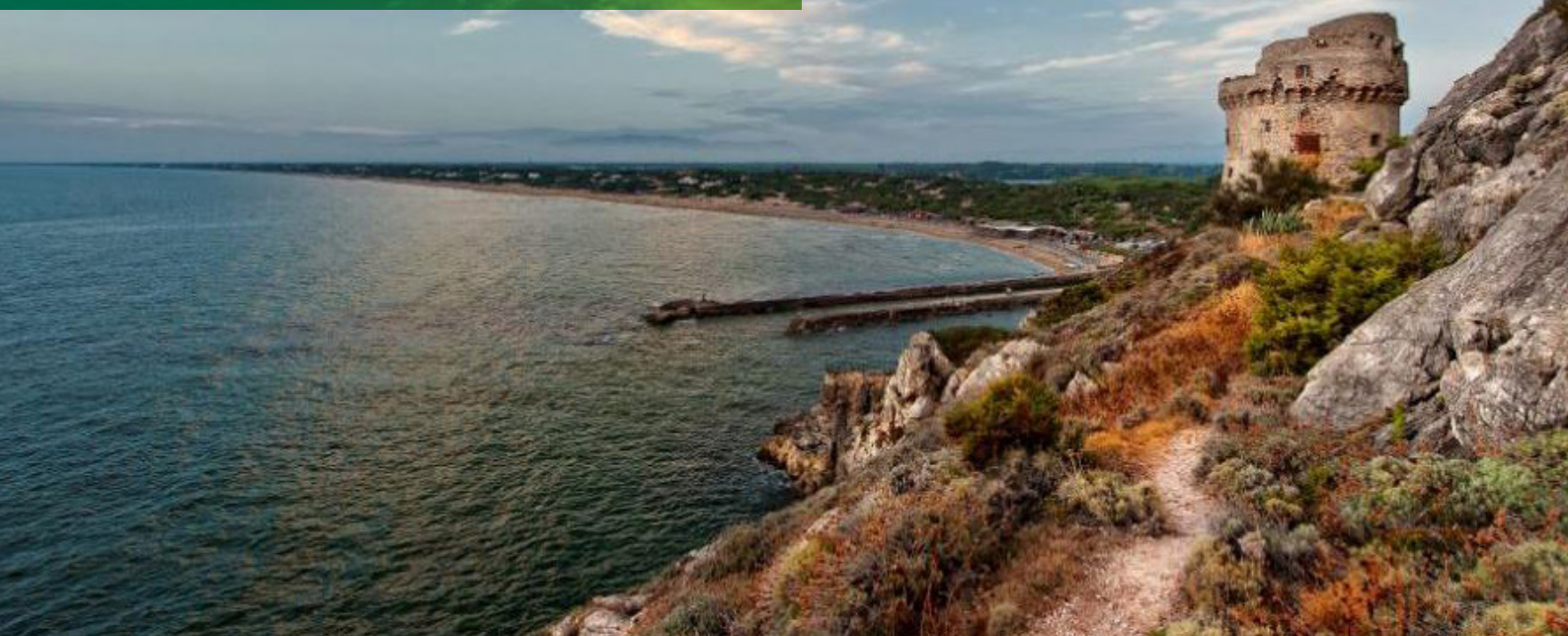

A sustainable tourism in a blue economy: this is the goal of the Co-Evolve4BG project, whose partners are studying the key features of the sustainable development of coastal tourism, across five different countries. Seven pilot areas have been carefully selected to produce transferable results. A toolkit containing indicators to analyse the tourism sustainability level is being produced together with seven pilot actions. Project activities also include two rounds of training addressed to partners and local actors. The initiative is part of the wider project “Med Coast for Blue Growth” labelled by the 43 countries of the Union for the Mediterranean.
