Across the North, amber has been one of the major contributors to the cities' wealth over centuries, leaving a rich historical and cultural legacy. The largest source of amber in the Baltic region can be found between Gdansk and Kaliningrad. The project aims at protecting and promoting such heritage among local inhabitants and tourists of Gdansk and Kaliningrad. The partners have created a permanent exhibition in the new location of the Amber Museum – the Great Mill in Gdańsk. On the Russian side, the construction works of the Amber Manufactory complex in Kaliningrad are being implemented. The project activities help to promote the history and cultural heritage of both cities, and to attract new visitors to the cross-border region.
