More than 500 people in the border regions of Russia and Latvia do crafts using local resources and traditional skills. Yet, many artisans need support in turning their passion into successful businesses. The CRAFTS project promotes craftsmen from remote cities and villages by organising large-scale events such as fairs and exhibitions. It creates spaces for workshops, interactive master classes and exhibitions, and it buys equipment for metalworking, ceramics, textile and woodworking across six cultural and historical sites of the cross-border region. Moreover, the project partners improve the artisans' marketing skills through a number of trainings, and launch an Internet platform craftsgoods.com to enable craftsmen to showcase and sell their products, feed own blogs and deliver master classes.
