ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The Prut River is the last largest inflow of the Danube before it meets the Black Sea. It springs in Ukraine and flows through the border area between Romania and the Republic of Moldova. Combining preservation of aquatic bio-resources in the Lower Meadow Prut River together with the economic potential of the area, is the focus of the CROSS ECOSS PRUT project. The data from the field research assesses the impact of human factors and climate change on aquatic bio-resources, while the field analysis on socio – economic potential of the territory, outlines the types of activities and the limits to their development. The final study capitalizes the knowledge stock to identify green economy solutions and to encourage their integration by public and private sectors for the sustainable development of the cross-border area.
