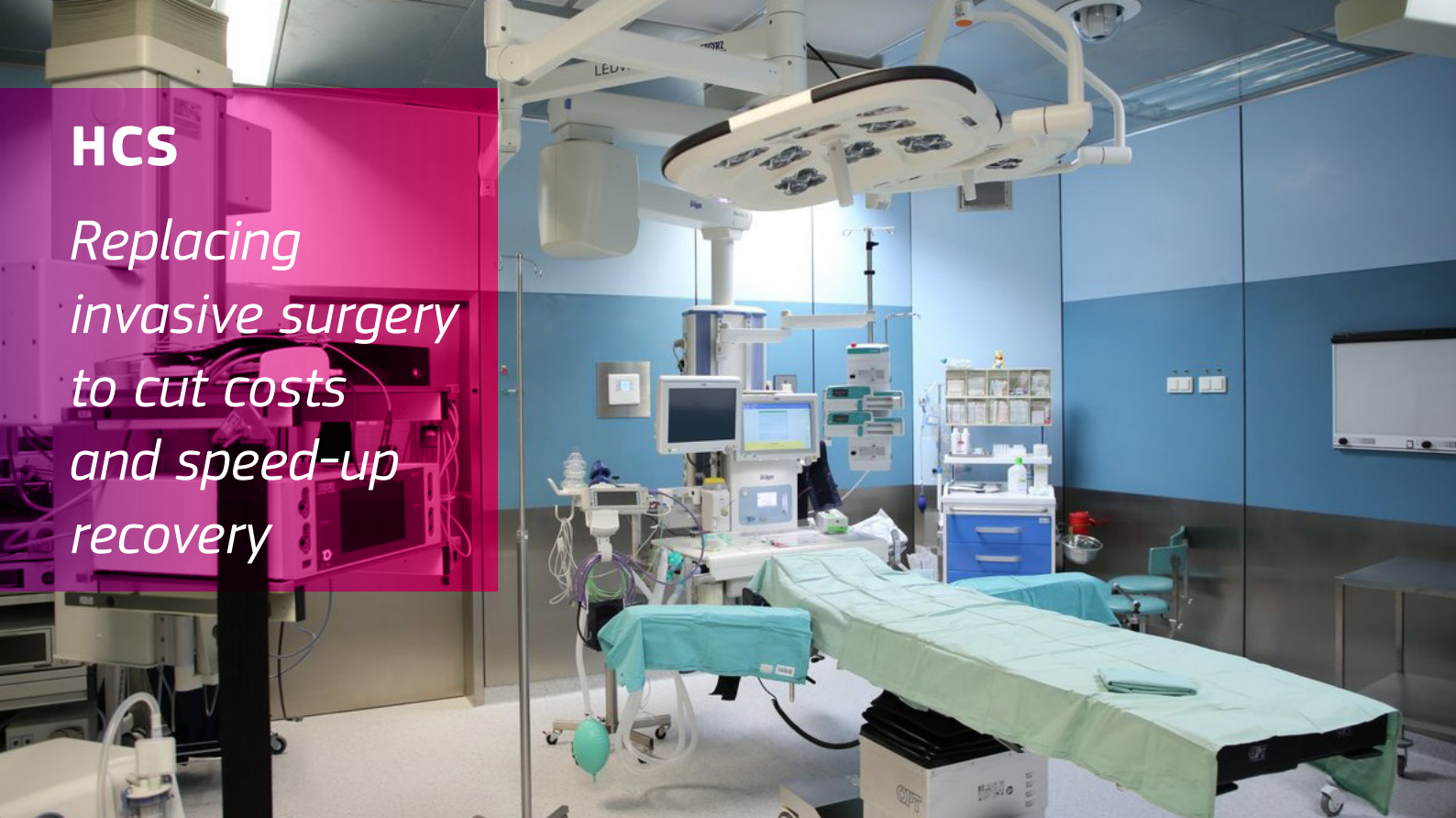

The residents of Ostrołęka (Poland) and Lviv (Ukraine) suffer from weak medical services. The surgical devices of hospitals in both cities are outdated, they frequently need repair and part of the operations must be conducted somewhere else. The HCS project wants to change that. The two hospitals are purchasing equipment for laparoscopic surgery for the gynaecologist, urologist and surgeons' units. This equipment will replace the traditional, more invasive surgery, enabling for faster recovery of the patients and shorter waiting time. Moreover, the modernization of the operations and conference hall in Lviv hospital is also being carried out. A new Telemedical Centre Lviv will be opened to exchange modern medical knowledge between the doctors working in both hospitals, where laparoscopy trainings and other workshops are being provided. Pro-health actions to raise people awareness of factors impacting on human health are also conducted.
