There is a common trend on both sides of the Mediterranean Sea: low empowerment of women and low participation in the labour force. The InnovAgroWoMed project aims at boosting the women employability and their entrepreneurial spirit in the agri-food sector, an industry rooted in the cultural identity of the Mediterranean regions. The project partners are redefining job profiles according to the needs of the agri-food sector in two European and two MENA regions. They are providing mentoring and coaching programmes and offering women traineeship schemes. And more: the idea is to ensure that women will have the necessary skills to be competitive, and to find a job or start a business. With this purpose, several fora are being organised to match job profiles with local businesses’ needs and different agreements will be sealed to create a local agri-food stakeholder network that matches job offers with jobseekers. The goal is to help women find a sustainable and desirable job, that will transform them into real change agents in the rural sector, thereby reducing poverty and boosting social inclusion.
