ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The overall objective of the project is to facilitate access to the tertiary education system by developing educational services and improving the capacity of human resources. To do so, the project partners are organizing online courses for high-school students on different topics related to the labour market such as entrepreneurship and leadership skills, or critical thinking. Within the project, professional counselling and career guidance are being offered to the students, as well as the organisation of job fairs. On the other hand, high-school teachers are benefitting from training courses on different educational topics and cross-border networking events are being organised. Lastly, the organisation of international mobility programmes both for the teachers and the students is also foreseen as part of the project activities. 500 members of the targeted group (students, teachers and parents) will benefit from an integrated value chain to improve their opportunities in the labour market.
