The project aims at improving the safety and security level of the population by increasing the intervention capacity of the emergency services and the structures responsible for carrying out interventions in the eligible area. The project partners are developing an information exchange platform that will serve as a common alert notification service and as an instrument to make decisions together in case of cross-border emergencies. The two institutions are also increasing their operational capacity by procuring special vehicles, technical means and equipment, as well as organising joint workshops and exercises to increase cross-border cooperation.
