CBC // Cross-border cooperation



North Ostrobothnia and Kainuu regions in Finland and the Republic of Karelia in Russia extend through vast geographic areas with relatively sparse population. The extent of the road network is large in comparison to transport volume. The LOGOKA project increases the knowledge of logistics and trade options among manufacturing, wholesale, export, and transport companies, to encourage cross-border business cooperation between Oulu-Kainuu region and Karelia. The partners are working to raise the awareness of the companies and stakeholders on the regulations and trade practices for transporting cargos between the Republic of Karelia in Russia and Finland, and to the markets beyond. They increase knowledge about the transport routes and develop new options for cross-border package delivery between Finland and Russia, including the shipping of online orders.
