The project is undertaking a major renovation of two former manor parks with a common history: they were former mansions of the nobles and now, thanks to the project they are being rehabilitated in order to be accessible to everyone. In particular, one of the parks will serve as a green recreational area for children with severe disabilities and their families. Apart from the renovation works, the project partners are providing training to park keepers (seminars, cross-border conferences) and they are creating an online visual guidebook with all the manor parks in the Russian-Latvian region. Once on the map, the final aim of the project is to promote the cultural and historical heritage of the region, bringing the historical manor parks closer to the people and reverting their natural tendency to aging.
