The objective of the project is to improve access of pregnant women and families with children aged 0 to 3 from the Romanian-Moldovan border area to good quality health services. The ultimate purpose is to reduce the number of newly registered cases of illness among children in seven targeted regions. To achieve that, the project partners are organising the visit of nurses and health professionals to approximately 1,700 beneficiaries (children and their families) – including those from the most marginalized and isolated communities – to provide them with counselling and high-quality health services. The implementation of this new home visiting programme will help in the prevention of disability and development issues at early and very early age. Thanks to the project, children will benefit from regular support and parents will have the knowledge and skills to ensure better care and a good development environment for their children.
