The partners of the PREZAK project work together to reconstruct and to modernize II/558, P53 and H13 roads in the Slovak - Ukrainian border area. Innovative solutions are used to reconstruct around 20 km of roads on both sides, and to repair two bridges in Slovakia and one in Ukraine, with particular attention to road safety. The reconstruction of these road sections allows for an improved and safer access to the Polonina National Park (Slovakia), and the Uzhánska Reserve (Ukraine). Better roads help to intensify local economic activities related to transport, tourism, social affairs and international transport on both sides, bringing benefits to the local inhabitants, tourists and transit passengers.
