The main objective of the project is to reduce pollution in the Black Sea basin by tracking and analysing the main waste streams and carrying out pilot activities to clean pre-defined areas. Project partners have created a computer model-map of waste distribution, linking the waste flows with the air and sea currents, to anticipate their movements and potential places of highest concentration. Cross-border cleaning campaigns are also organised to awake citizens’ interest in the preservation of the Black Sea marine environment.
