In the last few decades the urban areas of the Polish-Belarusian-Ukrainian borderland have become dominated by cars, negatively impacting the environment and people’s health. Traffic jams, poor air quality, noise pollution, limited accessibility to public transport are the common challenges for the cities of Pinsk (Belarus), Rzeszów (Poland) and Uzhhorod (Ukraine). The project develops Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans for Uzhhorod and Pinsk, improves small urban infrastructure (e.g. pedestrian crossings, public playgrounds, bicycle parking) and raises awareness of citizens on sustainable climate-proof urban mobility.
