The TEC-MED project is developing an innovative and cost-effective socio-ethical care intervention model that will improve and adapt social care policies to the ageing population. The new model is based on support, cooperation and partnership between public institutions and social care actors through agreements, coordinated actions and an online common platform, where “laboratories of ideas” will be set-up for designing innovative social services. Six pilot actions are being implemented in the participating countries to test and validate the model. They are involving social enterprises, citizens, and public administrations. Ultimately, the TEC-MED project will contribute to reduce the marginalization of elderly people and to improve the quality of the social services.
