ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION



An increased security at the EU's Eastern border is at the heart of the THOR project. Responding to the common challenges of the Romania-Moldova border area – such as criminal activities, tobacco smuggling, cybercrimes – the project partners increase the mobility and administrative capacity of police and border police units in both countries. It is planned to rehabilitate 30 police stations at the border, to build capacities of over 750 police officers in intelligence analysis, criminal investigations, organized crime, and to launch a cross-border collaborative IT platform.
