The Reformed Franciscan order has had a significant impact on the history of the border towns of Węgrów (PL) and Rawa Ruska (UA), leaving outstanding baroque monasteries built by Italian architects: the Church of St. Peter of Alcantara and St. Anthony of Padua (Węgrów) and the Abbey of Archangel Michael (Rawa-Ruska). The advanced state of damage of both religious sites did not allow to exploit their full potential, both as tourist objects and socio-educational centers. The TwinMonasteries project reconstructs the sacral buildings and adapts them as centers for Dialogue of Cultures, creating spaces for social, cultural, and educational activities. The renovated monasteries also offer the ground for a new cross-border tourist product – The Former Reformati Order’s Monasteries Route – aimed at increasing the tourist attractiveness of the area.
