TESIM has followed them closely and has contributed to the drafting of standard templates, such as the one for the subsidy contract and the partnership agreement, ensuring that neighbourhood CBC specificities were taken into account. Time to share with the community the full range of available tools!

Moreover, a significant number of Interreg NEXT programmes are considering to use JEMS as their monitoring system. This technical meeting will be an opportunity for them to directly address questions to Interact colleagues about the state of play in the development of JEMs and the next steps towards the use of the system by individual programmes.
