Lviv (Ukraine) and Przemyśl (Poland) are popular tourist destinations which attract an increasing number of tourists every year. Unfortunately, most museums and architectural landmarks are not accessible to people with disabilities. The project aims at providing the opportunities for the visually impaired and blind persons, as well as for those who use wheelchairs, to explore the unique cultural and architectural heritage of Lviv and Przemyśl. To that end, tourist routes are being adapted to the needs of persons with disabilities including ramps and developing technical and financial permits for this purpose; around 55 tour-guides are being trained to work with this group of visitors; and travel agencies are being informed and encouraged to plan tourist routes with special consideration for the people with special needs. Adapted city tours will be provided free of charge to everyone who is interested. Thanks to a joint international conference and an extensive promotional campaign, Lviv and Przemyśl are being presented as friendly cities to persons with disabilities and are attracting all kinds of tourists to visit the cross-border region.
