ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The project aims at enhancing the cross-border touristic potential of two sister countries by restoring the medieval fortress of Soroca, in Romania, and the Monumental Ensemble “Podul Inalt” which embodies the equestrian statue of Stefan cel Mare, in the Republic of Moldova. The project partners are organising two annual cultural festivals in both countries with joint attendance of the people from the neighbouring countries. The purpose of these festivals is to highlight and embrace the historical ties and legacy of the two countries, and to promote their common cultural and historical heritage. The project team is also developing a joint strategy to enhance the visibility of the historical touristic objects and to establish a stronger relationship between the museums of the two countries.
