The project aims at improving the quality of the services provided by primary healthcare institutions in Dolyna and Baia Sprie. The project partners are investing in infrastructure and equipment in the primary healthcare units of both towns. Training programmes, exchange of knowledge and working visits between the Ukrainian and Romania colleagues is also foreseen within the project. In addition, a wide information campaign is being organised among the local population to make known the services provided by the healthcare centres, this way increasing the medical consultations and the number of diagnosis. The project will potentially benefit more than 30,000 inhabitants of the two border regions, thanks to improved primary care health services and the information campaigns.
