Poor roads often limit the tourist traffic to cultural, historical or natural places of interest, especially if they are small or less known. This is the case of the Kostyukhnivka village in Manevychi District (Ukraine), the site of one of the largest World War I battles involving the Polish Legions. The FasterSafer project has modernized seven road sections on both Polish and Ukrainian sides resulting in 23,6 km of easily accessible roads with drainage systems, road vertical marking, new pavements, and energy-saving LED street lighting. The improved road infrastructure brings several benefits to the local population, such as increased travel safety, reduced travel time as well as fuel emissions, and more accessibility to places of interest, therefore local development.
