The main objective of the project is to increase cooperation between the countries that share the Uzh river basin, an area with a high risk of floods and also heavily affected by droughts. The project partners are working on these problems by providing reliable information about the catchment area, by developing a geographic information system (GIS model) and 2D models of different scenarios and by delivering flood risk management plans in line with the EU Directives. Conducting research on retention reservoirs and designing documentation for spatial planning is improving flood protection in the Uzh basin and enhancing the water regime of the adjacent communities.
