ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The aim of this project is to improve the access to the labour market of young people with disabilities from the Romanian (Iași) and Moldovan territories. In particular, the initiative focuses on improving career guidance services, and tailoring them to people with special needs. The project partners have developed training curricula, handbooks and quality standards for this purpose, they have trained 3,600 professionals from education and employment systems in both countries and they have informed more than 1,500 students and youngsters with disabilities on the inclusive career guidance services available for them. In addition, information workshops have been organised for the parents to understand their role and support their children in becoming more independent. Thanks to the project activities, career guidance services for people with disabilities have been regulated within the Employment Agency of the Republic of Moldova and recommendations for improving the policies and practices of these services have been provided to decision-makers and other relevant stakeholders.
