The father Salesian Bronisław Markiewicz founded schools for the poor and orphaned youth in the region under the approach of "education through work and culture". His method inspired the project partners to create educational centres for youth in Poland and Ukraine. In the framework of the project, two facilities – one on each side of the border – are being built to allow the youth to meet and attend workshops related to culture, history and the identity of the region. The facilities host a conference room, a theatre space and a hall for shows. Workshops on photography, theatre and iconography have also been organised for the Polish and Ukrainian teenagers. This way the project team is improving the integration of borderland residents by fostering cultural exchanges and dialogue and, at the same time, attracting the youth to the cultural and historical heritage of the region.
