The OpenBordersZosin project has constructed a new exit platform from Poland at the Zosin-Ustyluh border-crossing point, with new check-in passes, including three new clearance lanes, two clearance pavilions, squares, roads, sidewalks, lighting, electric and telecommunication systems and necessary equipment. The new pavilions functionally separate parts the Border Guard Service and the Customs and Tax Service. The project activities help to facilitate the traffic of people, goods and services as well as to strengthen controls and increase safety at the border with the aim of enhancing cross-border connections between Poland and Ukraine.
