Roztocze is a picturesque range of hills stretching from south-east Poland to the western Ukraine. It is a multicultural area with unique geography and ecosystems of a great value. The Polish and Ukrainian partners of the PLUARoztocze project invested into the development of tourism infrastructure, raising ecological awareness among local citizens and tourists, about the valorization of the eco-tourism potential of the region. The project has created a 300-km bike route with bike stops and service points, wooden sheds, information boards and watchtowers together with by a mobile app and publications to attract local and foreign tourist. As well, two centers (one in Poland, one in Ukraine) were built to foster environmental education among the population; they also serve as places for natural and cultural exhibitions, meetings for youth and folklore groups and tourist information points. The cross-border approach, based on a linear infrastructure and tourist products with an eye on nature protection, has resulted in creating objects which can be used by all "together in spite of borders".
