Cystic Fibrosis (CF) is an incurable rare genetic disease that has a big influence on the life quality of patients and families. The project partners are creating a specialised CF centre, they are providing medical tools and equipment for home care and for the specialised centres and they are training healthcare professionals from Slovakia and Ukraine in matters such as diagnostics, treatment, physiotherapy nutrition and daily care. The project partners are also working together to advocate and influence public institutions about the need to improve the situation of patients with this rare disease and, specifically, to ensure better financing and access to new therapies. The project has also contributed to expanding to Ukraine and Slovakia a mobile phone application that teaches the youngest patients to better perform their daily inhalations and home care, this way turning the treatment into a game. Thanks to the project, cooperation between the regions of Slovakia and Ukraine is strengthened and contributing to guaranteeing better life conditions for CF patients and for their family members.
