A completely new, interactive way of benefitting from the museum experience. The SmartMuseum project aims at attracting visitors to the cultural sites of the border areas of Hungary, Slovakia and Ukraine, linked by common history and culture. The project partners are working to assist three museums in Slovakia, two in Hungary and one in Ukraine, to present their cultural and historical heritage in a new way, using smart technologies. The six museums will be able to offer interactive tourist attractions based on digital technologies and will be part of a cross-border touristic network. This net is enabling the exchange of knowledge and experience, as well as the developing of joint projects and the mutual promotion of partners' museums. The staff is also being trained in the use of smart technologies, to present and give a new life to historical and cultural heritage. Lastly, the project partners are undertaking the renovation of part of the Palanok Castle (Ukraine) and improve its preservation conditions.
