Decreasing the police response time in Lviv (UA) from 15 to 5 minutes, when informed about a crime, is the objective of the SoDR project. According to a survey conducted in Lviv, 76% of inhabitants feel safe in the city during the day and only 40% at night. The project implementation aims to increase these numbers to 85% and 60% respectively. A new administrative building equipped with a system of data collection from CCTV city cameras and an integrated multiservice telecommunication system, six reconstructed police stations, an improved emergency communication subsystem are the key elements brought in by the project to improve the work of the emergency services and to provide security and required help to the citizens and visitors of Lviv.
