The “Carpathian Mobility” project connects the two existing cycling circuits – the Poloniny Trail on the Slovak side and the Užanský Trail on the Ukrainian one. Both countries are part of the European network of Eurovello cycling routes whose long-term vision is to link cycling routes across Europe. The partners focus on modernization and improvement of over 6 km of cycle paths adding the elements of cycling infrastructure, such as intelligent rest shelters, bicycle parking lots, information stands and maps of the cycling routes. A technical study prepared by the Slovak beneficiaries is supposed to connect the the Poloniny cycle path to the current border crossing Ubl’a- Malé Berezné. Moreover, the partners are carrying out activities aimed at local governments, business and non-profit sector to build a community and raise awareness on the new products.
