The CLIMA project, – and its regional platform of Italian, Tunisian and Lebanese partners – aims at addressing the problem of organic waste mismanagement in the three Mediterranean countries. The partners have developed a multifaceted approach, on one hand developing policy tools, like the Municipal Waste Management Plans; on the other exploring innovative technical solutions, such as the “compost drum” and setting up improved pilot compost sites.
