The CLUSTER project aims to tackle social exclusion and poverty amongst vulnerable groups in Cyprus, France, Italy, Jordan, Palestine, Spain, and Tunisia, by equipping young NEETs (Not in Education, Employment or Training) and women with marketable skills in the sectors of Blue Economy, Circular Economy, Green Economy and Sustainable Agriculture. This is being done not only through the identification of the catalogues of skills needed in the four sectors, but also by training NEETs on-site and on-line. A traineeship scheme has been identified: coaching and tutoring will be essential to acquire skills and work experiences needed to enter the labour market. Together with the private sector and the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) institutions, the project introduces social economy as a key player in improving employment policies. The ultimate goal is to create a supportive environment for the implementation of youth/women employment schemes.
