Rescue teams across the Polish-Ukrainian borderland are facing various threats, such as large forest fires, chemical contamination, floods, as well as epidemiological and ecological threats. Nevertheless, their work is often limited due to poor coordination between rescue services and low accessibility to professional trainings, resulting in a long reaction time of rescue operations. Keeping the safety of residents in mind, the COORDINATION project aims at establishing new, fully equipped centers to conduct specialized trainings and exchange experiences involving fire and rescue units. The most realistic simulations on saving people, extinguishing fires, addressing chemical rescue operations will be performed in such centres, to improve firefighters’ skills and to settle operational procedures. In addition, the project foresees the purchase of new equipment, including firetrucks (ecological rescue, reconnaissance, water rescue, anti-gas/anti-smoke), defibrillators, high-pressure compressors, etc. By tightening the cooperation, the partners will have an opportunity to significantly reduce the reaction time and losses.
