The two neighbouring border districts – Zamojski Powiat in Poland and Sokal Raion in Ukraine – have in common untouched natural sights (including “NATURA 2000” area near Zamość), as well as many objects of cultural heritage, such as 16th century Bernardin Monastery in Sokal (Ukraine) or the 18th-century wooden church and cemetery in Dub (Poland). The ECORoads project improves the accessibility of these sights as well as the connection to the border crossings of Zosin–Ustyluh and Hrebenne–Rava-Ruska through reconstruction of two roads in Zamojski Powiat for the total length of 11.4 km, providing as well new pavements and bus platforms, energy-saving barriers, photovoltaic lighting and road markings. Similar works were carried out in Sokal Raion for the modernisation of 2.6 km of roads in Zhvyrka, Zabuzhzhya and Huta. All works are based on environment-friendly solutions – this was communicated to pupils during the lessons on road safety and pro-ecological solutions organised by the partners in five primary schools.
