Nowadays environmental education is essentially confined to extracurricular time, without any adapted pedagogy. This happens mostly through environmental clubs, where activities remain punctual, with not so encouraging results. Strategically, environmental education should be introduced into schools' curricula, to be able to consolidate eco-friendly behaviours in the long-term. And this is the main objective of the EdEn-MED project: Environmental Education for a Sustainable Mediterranean. The project is part of the challenge to build a society deeply rooted in environmental culture. This is being achieved through the establishment of an exchange platform and a mobility network between Tunisia and Sicily, where project's partners undertake a series of activities, like awareness campaigns, trainings, and the development of a manual, designed to increase the capacity building of both teachers and students.
