ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The “Dyakovtsi – Rakovec” border-crossing point at the Ukrainian-Romania border is now more accessible thanks to the improvement of 4,9 km of the T-26-04 Chernivtsi – Hertsa – “Dyakovtsi” road. Several different activities were implemented in the frame of the ICBT project: restoring and expanding the road surface, repairing the bridge, installing new road infrastructure, and implementing road safety measures. The Ukrainian and Romanian partners are also working on a joint strategy for the development of transport in the cross-border region of Bucovina and Botoșani. The project contributes to the improvement of transit capacities and infrastructure between the two countries.
