Pollution inputs have radically changed the transboundary aquatic ecosystems in the Black Sea Basin area. The MONITOX project aimed at enhancing regional cross-border cooperation to improve joint monitoring of environmental toxic pollution. Among the objectives of the project was the exchange of new analysis methodology, data, and information on ecological state and human health impact of harmful substances. Project partners deal with several activities: specialized trainings, innovative practices, modern tools (virtual laboratory training, pollution maps prepared with free GIS software etc.). All this reinforced the expertise and research capacities of the partner institutions, and supported them in assessing the complex environmental issues in the BSB.
