The Hutsuls represent an ethnic group living mainly in the cross-border area of Bistra (RO)- Rakhiv (UA), two regions from different countries which share a common culture. To preserve and promote the Hutsul historical heritage, the partners of the project “Pro Hutsul” cooperate with a series of initiatives. The first is the rehabilitation of the Memorial House “Havrelo Klempus” from Bistra (RO) and the “Burkut Amphitheater” from Rakhiv, two important sites representative to the culture of this ethnic minority. Then 80 Members of the Hutsul ensembles of both areas will exchange cultural events aimed at raising awareness of their presence in the Romania-Ukraine cross-border region and at promoting project activities. The initiative is implemented within the Romania-Ukraine ENI CBC programme.
