District nursing service and counselling Centers are not available in Ukraine, where disadvantaged young mothers are often left without professional advice in health issues related to pregnancy and childcare. The project intends to respond to health needs of families with newborn and small children (0-3 years) living in Berehove city and Beregovo district/Berehove Raion (UA) through the introduction and widening of Sure Start program services and the provision of counselling in most disadvantaged settlements of the region. Thanks to this cross-border cooperation, not only these services will be finally available in Ukraine, but will also be improved in Hungary, in the Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén County. As a result, it is expected that the health of young mothers/parents and kids attending the Centres and involved in counselling will improve and awareness in issues related to pregnancy and baby-care increase.
