Limited access to medical services has posed a problem for thousands of patients in the border area between Romania and the Republic of Moldova, particularly exacerbated during the COVID pandemic. The “Cross-border Medical Consulting Center” project offers a solution through telemedicine. The Medical Consulting Center - opened in the District Hospital of Cimişlia (MD) - gives access to over 3.000 patients from the cross-border area to professional medical services with no need to travel. The space was renovated and equipped with modern high-performance medical facilities and a teleconference room for inter-clinic consultation. Seminars, meetings, round tables and medical education training helped to increase the professionalism of medical staff of the partner organisations.
