The ArtSpace project bonds the efforts of small cross-border regions to position themselves as tourist destinations with an appealing tourist package which includes cultural programmes. The project has created three cross-border Art Space cultural centers based on three reconstructed historical & cultural sites in SK, HU and UA. It has also mapped and promoted local tourist attractions, and it has presented the cultural heritage of the three countries in over 40 activities organized in the frame of the project. Moreover, cultural managers and local producers got a chance to acquire new skills in tourism product development and marketing.
